Dear Members,

We are pleased to announce a restricted reopening of the Club beginning June 12, 2020.

Our Club Director, Chris Manos, has worked diligently on a reopening plan that will protect the health of the members and the staff. He has established physical distancing and cleaning protocols for the gym, cardio room, and the pools in compliance with the California Department of Public Health, Los Angeles County of Public Health as well as the Center for Disease Control.

Though we will be reopening, things will not be the same until the pandemic comes under control. Use of the Club will be by reservation only and limited to the gym, cardio room and pool – for lap swimming only. Reservations will be taken by telephone between 4pm – 8pm the day before your visit. Visits will begin at 45 minutes after the hour followed by a 15-minute cleaning protocol. The pool deck and locker rooms will remain closed although it is hoped that these will open in the not-too-distant future. Exercise classes will continue to be conducted on Zoom.

In accordance with the orders of the California and LA County Department of Public Health, the following rules and restrictions will apply:

- Members are required to wear a mask or a cloth face covering at all times with the exception of while swimming.
- Members must maintain a 6ft minimum social distance at all times.
- Members are required to bring their own towels, goggles and water.
- Sunbathing, reading, eating, gathering or socializing on the pool deck are not permitted.
- Lockers will be available upon request
- Water fountains, showers, steam room, sauna, spas and BBQs are unavailable at this time.
- The Club Room, Pacific Cove Lounge and Aerobics Room remain closed. There will be no massage appointments at this time.
- No guests or day passes permitted.

Please be advised that LA County Health Department may change their orders at any time. Further, our protocols are subject to City and County review and may be changed as a result.

We understand that the Club's closure has been very challenging for all of us. Your Board appreciates your patience and understanding. We look forward to a safe and healthy reopening.
